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1. General description of the data set, and IRB Approval # (if available):

The data shows participant pairs playing the barrier game. There are two groups of participant pairs: 1) a person who stutters with their partner (who does not stutter), and 2) person who does not stutter with their partner who also does not stutter. There are a total of five participant pairs in each group. During the barrier game, a low barrier was placed between partners, with a numbered board (1 to 12) placed in front of each partner. At the start of each trial, one participant had twelve cards placed in a specific order (by the researcher) on the numbered board, while the other partner was given the identical cards randomly ordered in a stack. During the game, partners had to work together to ensure identical placement of cards on the both boards. The data set was collected at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (IRB Approval #12011).
