1. General description of the data set, and IRB Approval # (if available):

The data consist of monthly language samples of 9 children who stutter over a period of 10 months. The children began the study in their preschool years, ages 2;1 to 4;11 (years;months). The context of each language sample is play-based conversation with a trained graduate clinician. Stimuli included a standard set of interactive toys and books. The data were collected from 2003 - 2005.

The study was approved by the Institutional Review Board (IRB) of the University of Missouri (IRB #1039525) on June 19, 2003. This IRB later approved the contribution of the transcripts only to TalkBank (on Sept. 25, 2018). Because of the number of years that had elapsed since the data were collected, in was not possible to obtain consent from the children or their parents to contribute the data.

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Only transcripts are to be shared with researchers (no audio or video). Please remove any references to names.
