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1. General description of the data set, and IRB Approval # (if available):

The project evaluated normal dysfluencies in Singaporean English-Mandarin Chinese bilingual children who stutter and do not stutter. Data was collected from 2015 to 2019.

The data includes 147 sets of audio samples and transcripts: there are 37 participants and 4 recordings per participant with exception of 1 participant with 3 recordings. For each participant, there are 2 recordings in English and 2 in Mandarin Chinese: 1 narrative tell sample and 1 narrative retell sample per language. The narrative samples are based on 'Frog Goes to Dinner' and 'One Frog Too Many'.
